Representatives for the City announced today that Glendale is launching a new after hours hotline for residents and business people to call to report a problem. People will now be able to access a “live” City representative 24 hours a day, including weekends, by calling the City’s After-Hours Hotline at **818-550-4400**. Residents and business owners should continue to call 9-1-1 for all police or fire related emergencies.

With the addition of the new hotline, people will now be able to report various problems and incidents including but not limited to:

- Traffic Signal Malfunction
- Code Enforcement Related Matters
- Illegal Construction
- Fallen Tree Limbs
- Graffiti Removal
- Illegal Dumping
- Malfunctioning Street Lights
- Potholes
- Damaged Sidewalks
- Animal Related Concerns
