Dear Resident, Business and Property Owner:

By this notification, the City of Glendale would like to inform you of the major construction activities that will be taking place over the next few months in connection with the Fairmont Avenue Extension project. These construction activities will have impacts on the traffic operations within San Fernando Road and Fairmont Avenue, and in turn on the nearby streets in the project area. Below is a listing of the upcoming major construction activities and their respective traffic impacts.

**Bridge Columns Within San Fernando Road Corridor**

Construction Period:

September 30, 2008 through October 31, 2008.

Construction Activity:

The contractor will conduct its bridge column construction activities in an area to the east of the railroad tracks – between Doran Street and Fairmont Avenue. During the above construction period, four columns will be constructed between the west curb of San Fernando Road and the railroad tracks. The columns will be in general alignment of the existing freeway columns along San Fernando Road. Construction of the columns will require mobilization of heavy construction equipment within San Fernando Road and delivery and installation of large and heavy steel cages for the columns.

Traffic Impacts:

During the above construction period, the traffic lanes on San Fernando Road will be reduced to two lanes – one lane in each direction. Additionally, for public safety considerations, during the period of October 1, 2008 and October 31, 2008, full closure of San Fernando Road - between Fairmont Avenue and Doran Street - will take place. The full closure will be during the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. - During the full closure of San Fernando Road, the at-grade railroad crossing of Doran Street will also be closed.

**Tie-in of a Realigned Gas Line/ Removal of the Abandoned Gas Line Within Fairmont Avenue**

Construction Period:

October 1, 2008, through October 10, 2008

Construction Activity:

The tie-in of the realigned gas line will take place during the above construction period.

Traffic Impacts:

During this construction, the travel lanes on Fairmont Avenue will be reduced to one lane in each direction. Full closure of Fairmont Avenue, between San Fernando Road and the freeway ramps at Fairmont Avenue, may also take place on occasion.

Extended Working Hours:

The Gas Company may require working late for the tie-in of the realigned gas line to the existing gas line facilities. The tie-in operation will start on the morning of October 1, 2008 at 6:00 a.m. and may continue uninterrupted until midnight.

## **Construction of Pile Foundations Within Fairmont Avenue**

### **Construction Period:**

September 24, 2008, through October 31, 2008

### **Construction Activity:**

The contractor will conduct its bridge pile construction activities within Fairmont Avenue – between the freeway ramps at Fairmont Avenue and San Fernando Road. During the above construction period, twenty two piles will be constructed within the ultimate Fairmont Avenue right-of-way. Construction of the piles will require mobilization of heavy construction equipment within Fairmont Avenue and delivery of large and heavy steel cages for the pile foundations.

### **Traffic Impacts:**

During this construction, the travel lanes on Fairmont Avenue will be reduced to one lane in each direction. Full closure of Fairmont Avenue, between San Fernando Road and the freeway ramps at Fairmont Avenue, may also take place on occasion

### **City Contacts:**

The Public Works Department is mindful of the public inconveniences during the above construction activities, and will be monitoring the construction activities to address and minimize the related traffic impacts as much as possible. Traffic detours will be provided to maintain through traffic on major streets/arterials.

We would appreciate your comments and would like to take this opportunity to thank you in advance for your patience and understanding for the inconveniences during the construction period.
